CWU Wins Award for Student Center

Architecture firm Ambia and Central Washington University's Student Union Building and Recreation Facility (SUBREC) were awarded the 2007 Association of College Unions International (ACUI) Facility Design Award of Excellence.

"Projects are judged on appearance, the design process and how they impact the campus," writes the *Journal*.

The Student Union Building houses the university's store, food service and dining facilities, student services and administrative offices, a conference center with ballroom and theater spaces, and the campus radio station. The Recreation Center includes gymnasiums, specialized activity spaces, locker rooms, and a wellness center. Both facilities are adjoined by a commons area that features a large fireplace and 55-foot climbing wall.

The SUBREC also received an Outstanding Sports Facility Award from the National Intramural-Recreational Sports Association.
